## Chunky Cosmo Jacket

Read Instructions Completely before you start!

Skill Level: Intermediate



### Sizes

### Materials

#### Yarn required:

Misti Baby Alpaca Hand Paint Chunky (100% Baby Alpaca, Hand Paint 100g = approx 108 yards),

Col 1: (8) 8 (9) 10 (11) 12 hanks

Misti Baby Alpaca Chunky (100% Baby Alpaca, 100g = approx 108 yards)

Col 2 : 8903 (1) 1 (2) 2 (3) 3 hanks

#### Accessories:

1 large button.

Knitting needles: Circular and double pointed 6 mm (US No. 10) ndl.  
Adjust ndl sizes as needed to obtain correct gauge.

### Gauge/Tension

Gauge: 14 seed sts with 6 mm (US No. 10) = 10cm (4 in).

### Instructions

#### Seed stitch:

Row 1: [K1, p1] repeat [ ].

Row 2: K on p st, p on k st.

Repeat these 2 rows throughout the work.

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**Front and back:**

With 2 strands of col 2 and 6 mm (US No. 10) ndl cast on (120) 126 (132) 138 (142) 148 sts. K 2 rows back and forth (= 1 garter st ridge). Change to one strand of col 1 and cont seed st for entire work as described above. Place a marker at each side with (74) 76 (80) 84 (86) 88 sts for back and (23) 25 (26) 27 (28) 30 sts for front panel. At the same time inc 1 st at each side on the 2<sup>nd</sup> row as follows: (1<sup>st</sup> row from RS): K1, inc 1 st by lifting yarn up between 2 sts and work this new st twisted, work until 2 sts before end of row, inc 1 st in the same manner, k1. Inc in this manner every other row a total of 11 times.

At the same time, when jacket meas 3 cm (1¼ in), dec 1 st at each side of both markers as follows: Work until 2 sts before the first side marker, k2tog, sl 1, k1, pssso. Repeat in the same manner at each side of the other side marker (= 4 sts dec on row). Dec in this manner every (3½) 4 (4) 4 (4) 4½ cm (1¼, 1½, 1½, 1½, 1½, 1½ in) a total of 7 times. When jacket meas (27) 28 (29) 30 (31) 32 cm (10¾, 11, 11½, 11¾, 12¼, 12½ in) from cast on, make one buttonhole just to the inside of 6 sts on right front. (**Buttonhole:** BO sts and next row cast on 4 new sts over the bound off sts). **Next row:** Dec 1 st along both side of front edges every 2<sup>nd</sup> row until jacket meas (32) 33 (34) 35 (36) 38 cm (12½, 13, 13½, 13¾, 14¼, 15 in) from cast on. Divide work at each side by markers and finish each part separately.

**Back:**

**Shape armholes:** Cont seed st and BO at each side every other row 3, 2, 1 sts = (48) 52 (52) 56 (58) 62 sts remaining. When jacket meas (50) 52 (54) 56 (58) cm (19¾, 20½, 21¼ 22, 22¾ in), **shape neckline:** BO the (20) 22 (23) 24 (24) 26 center sts and work each side separately. At neck edge BO every other row 1 st twice = (12) 13 (13) 14 (15) 16 shoulder sts remaining. When jacket meas full given length, BO shoulders sts. Work the other side in the same manner.

**Right front:**

Shape armhole in the same manner as on back. Cont dec at front edge as before until (12) 13 (13) 14 (15) 16 shoulder sts remaining. When front meas same height as back, BO all sts.

**Left front:**

Work left front in the same manner as right front but mirror image.

**Sleeves:**

Work both sleeves in the same manner. With 2 strands of col 2 and 6 mm (US No. 10) double pointed ndl cast on (51) 55 (57) 61 (63) 67 sts. Join and work 1 garter st ridge (k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd = 1 ridge). Change to one strand of col 1 and k 1 rnd at the same time dec 6 sts evenly spaced = (45) 49 (51) 55 (57) 61 sts remaining. Cont seed st as described above. When sleeve meas (3) 3½ (4) 4½ (4½) 4½ cm (1¼, 1¼, 1½, 1½, 1½, 1½ in). **Next rnd dec as follows:** [K2tog, p2tog], repeat [ ] a total of 3 times evenly spaced in the rnd (= 6 sts dec) = (39) 43 (45) 49 (51) 55 sts remaining. (**Note:** Start the dec over k st in the previous rnd, so that the patterns match up). Cont established pattern without dec for (3) 3½ (4) 4½ (4½) 4½ cm. **Next rnd:** Dec 6 sts as before = (33) 37 (39) 43 (45) 49 sts remaining. When sleeve meas (16) 18 (20) 21 (22) 23 cm (6¼, 7, 8, 8¼, 8¾, 9 in). **Note:** Place a marker on the first st of rnd indicating underarm st. Inc 1 st at each side of underarm st approx every 2 cm (¾ in) a total of 11 times for all sizes = (55) 59 (61) 65 (67) 71 sts. When sleeve meas (38) 40 (42) 44 (46) 48 cm (15, 15¾, 16½, 17¼, 18, 19 in). **Dec for sleeve cap:** BO the 7 sts at centered underarm and cont seed st back and forth. At the same time BO at beg of every row 2, 1 sts = (42) 46 (48) 52 (54) 58 sts remaining. BO all sts.

**Finishing:**

Sew front and back shoulders tog. Sew in sleeves.

**Collar:**

Beg on left front panel where the dec beg at front edge. With col 1 and 5.5 mm (US No. 9) ndl knit up 7 sts per 5 cm (2 in) along the neck edge. Work seed st back and forth, at the same time BO 2 sts beg of every row a total of 7 times. Then cont remaining sts back and forth with out dec until collar meas 17 cm (6¾ in) in height at center-back. BO.

Beg at lower edge of right front panel. With col 2 and 5.5 mm (US No. 9) ndl knit up approx 7 sts per 5 cm (2 in) along the right front edge, around the collar and down along the left front edge. Turn and work k 4 rows back and forth (= 2 garter st ridges). BO. Attach button on left front.
